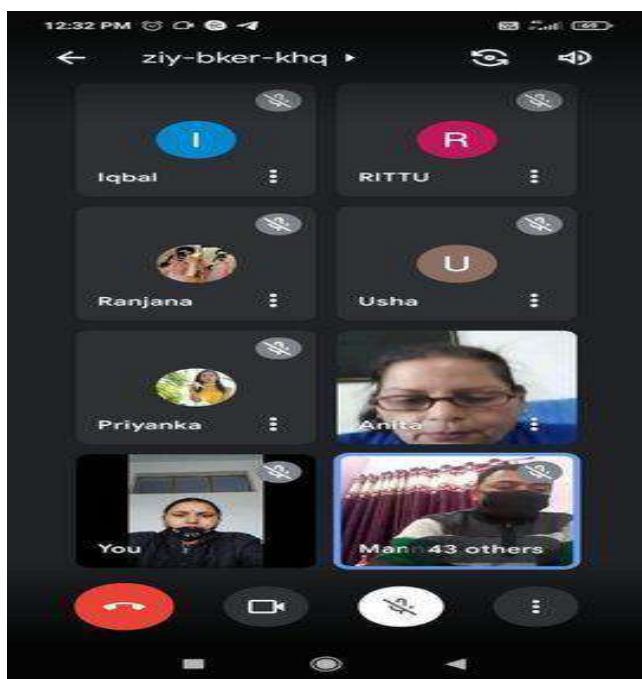
GUEST LECTURE ON "NEW EDUCATION POLICY 2020"

VISIT TO MODEL GIRLS HR. SECONDARY SCHOOL

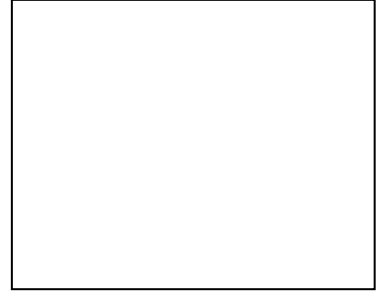

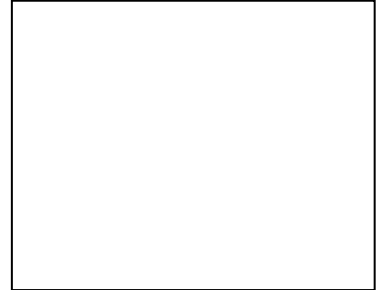
15TH March 2021

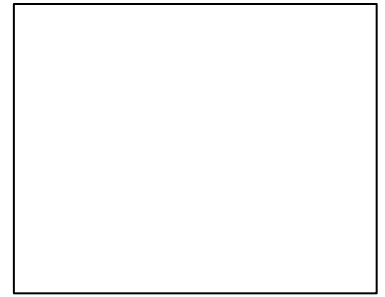

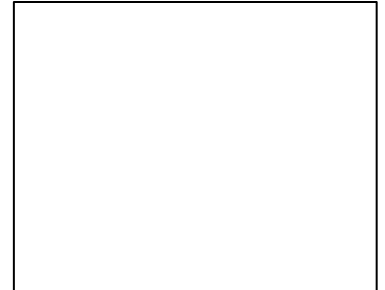
