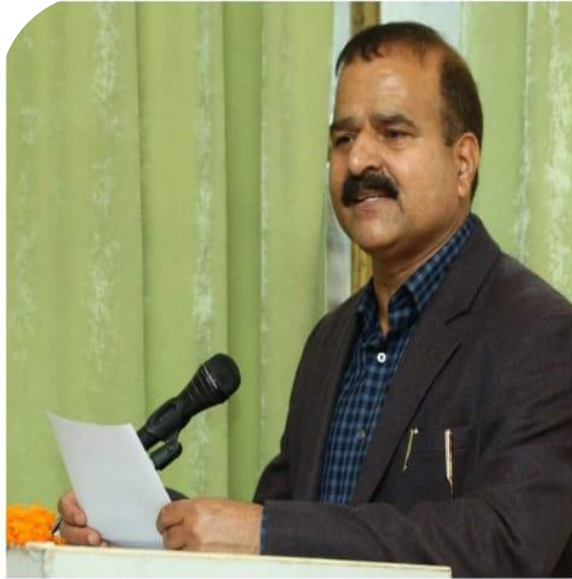
22nd Nov 2018
