


From The Principal Desk...

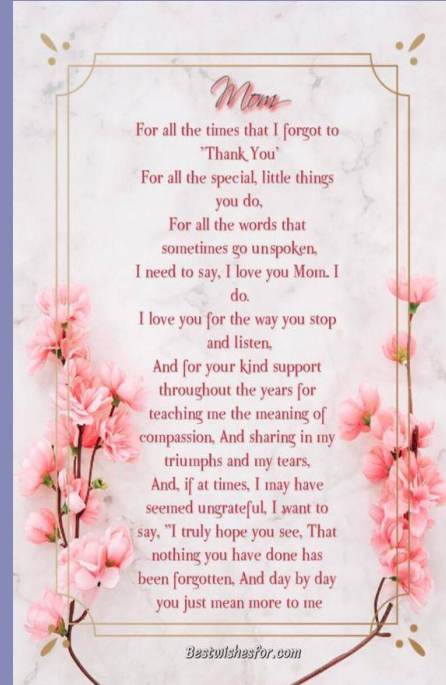
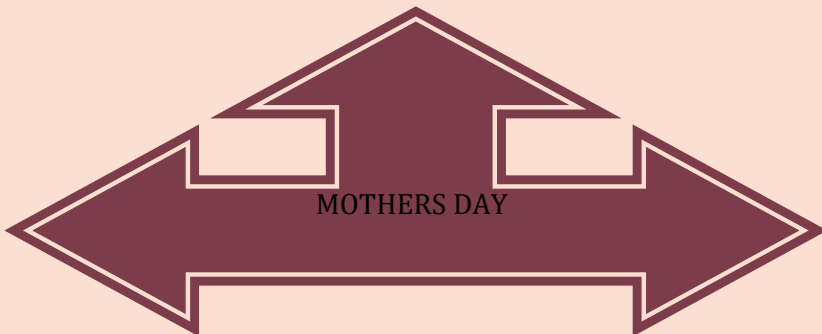
22nd April, 2022

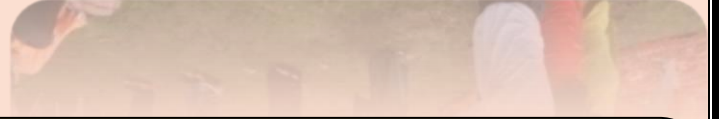
KARGIL VIJAY DIWAS

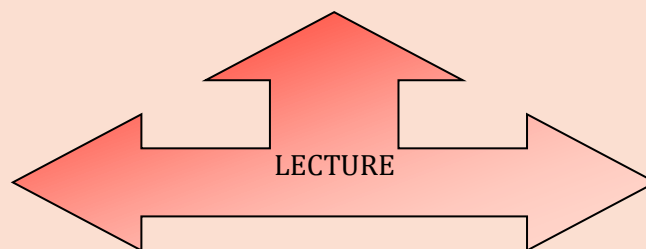

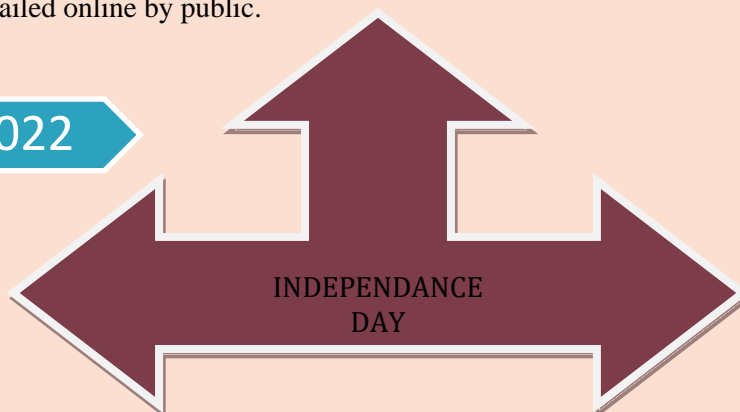
